




Installation Steps (Android Only):




Step 1:
After scanning QR code. Enter email & select sign-up.




Step 2:
Scroll down to step




Step 3:
Select 'Get started' button to accept invitation.





Select checkbox to give consent to Firebase









Allow Unknown App Installation

For Modern Android Versions (Android 8.0 Oreo and higher)

Modern Android versions use a per-app permission model, which is more secure than the old global setting.

1. **Open** the **Settings** app.
2. Navigate to **Apps & notifications** (or simply **Apps**).
3. Tap on **Special app access** (you may need to tap **Advanced** first on some devices).
4. Select **Install unknown apps**.
5. You will see a list of your installed apps. **Tap** on the specific app you are using to download or open the APK file (e.g., **Chrome**, **My Files**, or **Files**).
6. **Toggle on** the **Allow from this source** (or **Allow app installs**) switch.
7. Return to your download location and attempt to install the APK file again.

For Older Android Versions (Android 7.0 Nougat and below)

Older versions use a single global setting for all sources.

1. **Open** the **Settings** app.
2. Navigate to **Security** (or **Lock screen and security**).
3. Look for the **Unknown sources** option and **check** the box or **toggle** the switch to enable it.
4. Tap **OK** or **Allow** on the prompt message to confirm your choice.
5. You can now return to your download location and install the APK file.
